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## DELAWARE MARRIAGE BONDS AND MARRIAGE LAWS

Often the only evidence for a 19th century Delaware marriage is a marriage bond. These bonds are preserved in the Hall of Records in Dover, and are indexed in the marriages card file there. Existence of a bond does not prove that the marriage actually took place, but is evidence of an intent, as of the date of the bond, to enter into marriage soon after.

A bond is a written promise to pay money, to which the promissor's seal, as well as his signature, is affixed. In the case of marriage bonds, the promise was to the state, and the obligation was conditional, being of no effect if the parties were legally free to marry each other. The bond served to assure that there was no obstacle to the marriage, like an existing union, a close relationship, or lack of parental consent, and was a substitute for the advance public notice usually required before marriage.

Marriage bonds were first required in 1790 under "An Act to Regulate Marriages," 2 Del. Laws p. 972. It provided that unless the banns--formal notice of the intended marriage--were announced in the bride's church, the marriage could not be solemnized without a license, and a bond, the amount of which might vary, was required before the license could be granted. The act also required the minister or congregation to maintain a register of all marriages solemnized.

An earlier law of 1706, titled "An Act for Preventing Clandestine Marriages," 1 Del. Laws p. 39, illustrates the state's long-standing reliance on public marriage ceremonies, with witnesses, to prevent bigamy and similar abuses; "common law" marriages were not recognized.

Marriage bonds, which required the signatures and seals of both the bridegroom and another person as surety for the obligation, were promises to pay the State of Delaware a stated sum, with the condition that the obligation was void if (1) the parties to the proposed marriage could lawfully wed, that is, were not already married, were not related by blood or marriage either in the direct line, or collaterally as sister, brother, niece, nephew, aunt, uncle, great aunt or great uncle, and were not of a prohibited racial combination--white with mulatto or black--and (2) there was no legal objection to solemnizing the marriage, like lack of parental consent for minors, or of masters' consent for indentured servants or slaves.

Licenses were issued by the "President and Commander-in-Chief," as the state's chief executive was known until 1792, and the amount of the bond was at his discretion. However, the act permitted the president (governor after 1792) to deposit licenses with "sober, discrete and judicious people in different parts of the state for the ease and convenience of the people." A 1793 amendment provided that licenses should be lodged with the prothonotaries of the counties and the justices of the peace, "or such of them as the Secretary of State thinks fit."

The licenses themselves were presented to the officiating clergyman and have seldom survived, but the bonds, representing a potential monetary obligation due the state, were carefully preserved, and it is these documents that are now found at the Hall of Records. By 1826, the secretary of state was furnishing signed and sealed blank licenses to the clerks of the peace in each county, rather than to the prothonotaries, to distribute (not issue--the licenses had already been issued over the governor's signature), and they in turn could appoint justices of the peace, not less than six, to take the bond and grant licenses to the couples to be married.

Under a new "Act to Regulate Marriages," Del. Code (1829), p. 400, adopted in 1829, clergy were required to register all marriages with the appropriate county recorder of deeds annually in March, but many early ones were not recorded, although the provisions of the 1829 act remained generally unchanged until 1913. For a brief period, from 1 July 1861 to 19 March 1863, the clergy were required to register births and deaths, as well as marriages, with their respective recorders, paying 30 cents to register each event. This highly unpopular law was amended the following year to have the fee paid by the counties, but that was not enough to save it from repeal a year later, 12 Del. Laws pp. 94, 251, 338. Repeal restored the prior marriage act requirement that marriages be recorded annually in March, but a note to the section in the Del. Code (1893) states that at least one county recorder believed the section to be no longer in effect.

Under the 1829 act, a marriage license was necessary unless the banns were published immediately after divine services on two Sabbaths in a place of regular religious worship in the hundred (division of a county) where the bride resided, and no objection was made. The amount of the bond required for a license was fixed at \$200, and the condition was simplified to read, "if [name] and [name] may lawfully unite themselves in marriage, and if there be no legal objection to celebrating the rites of marriage between them, then the said obligation shall be void, otherwise in force."

If there was no church of the bride's denomination in the hundred where she lived, a marriage bond may well be on record. Even where there was a church, the schedule of Sunday services, as with many churches on rural Methodist circuits, may have been infrequent enough that the parties would marry by license rather than delay the wedding so banns could be announced on two Sundays when services were held.

As late as 1830 there were scarcely a dozen more-or-less active Episcopal churches in the state, with most of those in southern Delaware without rectors.

Until 1870 there were Catholic churches only in Wilmington, Christiana, New Castle, Mill Creek and Red Lion Hundreds, and for much of that period non-resident priests visited the latter two as infrequently as monthly, so marriage bonds can be expected for Catholic marriages unless the bride lived in Wilmington, New Castle, or Christiana Hundreds.

In 1913, "An Act Concerning Marriages and Marriage Licenses," 27 Del. Laws p. 771, comprehensively revised requirements, consistent with the proposed reintroduction that year of state-wide vital registration. Starting 1 May, 1913, a license would be required for all marriages, but without need for a bond. The license itself included two blank certificates of marriage to be completed by the clergyman and witnesses--one to be given to the couple, the other to be returned within four days to the clerk of the peace, and those in Wilmington to be reported monthly to the city registrar of vital statistics, then the only registrar in the state.

A week later, "An Act to Provide for a Uniform System of Registration of Marriages," 27 Del. Laws p. 206, was passed, requiring clerks of the peace starting 1 July 1913 to notify the state registrar immediately of all marriage licenses issued; officiating clergy were given the additional duty of registering their marriages monthly with the local registrar of vital statistics on forms prepared by the state registrar. Marriage bonds became a historical memory, and the modern series of governmental marriage records began.

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## DELAWARE MARRIAGES

FROM THE PUBLIC LEDGER, PHILADELPHIA, 1847--

The dedicated volunteers who have been extracting vital statistics from the Philadelphia Public Ledger for many years were prompted by one of their number, Caroline Sparks, to notice and put aside for the Journal references to Delaware marriages. These have accumulated a substantial body of data which we will present here and in subsequent issues.

## HISTORICAL BACKGROUND LOWER BRANDYWINE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH CEMETERY

By Anne Morris Mertz

The cemetery whose tombstones have been read by members of the Delaware Genealogical Society and recorded in the article which follows is not the complete Lower Brandywine Presbyterian Church Cemetery. It is the older section, begun in 1774, which is located at the front of the church. The church stands in the triangle of land at the junction of the Kennett Pike and the Old Kennett Road, one mile east of Centerville Delaware.

Preceding the present brick building was a black oak log structure, 30 by 35 feet, generally known as "The Old Log." The land was "given" by Jeremiah and Martha Smith for a "nominal fee" in 1774. This grant settled a long-standing dispute between the "Olde Side" and the "New Side" of the congregation of the Lower Brandywine Church. The original site had been in Birmingham Township near Marlborough in Chester County, Pennsylvania, on the east side of the Brandywine. That earlier log structure, which had served as a meetinghouse since 1720, became dilapidated and was no longer large enough for the growing congregation, more and more of whom lived on the west side of the Brandywine. This resulted in a controversy over the location of the proposed new church.

The grant by the Smiths was a deciding factor, and the "Old Log" (then very new) was built on the west side of the Brandywine, with a congregation of forty. A cemetery was begun, 215 years ago, at the front of the property. By 1835 the little building had been weatherboarded, plastered and made much more comfortable. Although the number of members remained small, the cemetery continued in use.

By 1859 a new brick building was built by the then 20 members. Now, in 1989, altered, enlarged and steepled, with stained glass windows, an organ and chimes, it houses a prosperous congregation numbering over 400.

The other part of the cemetery grew out of the need, early in the nineteenth century, for an Interdenominational burial ground. This was met by the formation of the Brandywine and Centerville Cemetery, a completely separate entity, whose trustees purchased land at the rear of the property occupied by the church. In 1883, this land was transferred to the adjoining Lower Brandywine Church. Greatly enlarged, it is still in use today.

What follows, then, is a record of the stones in the earlier portion, at the front of the church.

John C. McDowell, son of Wm. & Hannah McDowell died March 31 1865. Aged 34 years & one mo.

Sara Smith McDowell, Daughter of Wm. & Hannah McDowell Died in Dover, Del at John W. Caulks March 12th 1915 at 3 p.m. age 70 yrs 6 mo 1 day.

William McDowell; "Father was born May 30, 1804, died May 18, 1873, Sunday morning at 6 o'clock--was buried on \_\_\_\_\_ (illegible) at Newark. 'Trusting in Jesus' was almost his last words." Note added by his daughter, Susanna McDowell Davis.

What follows is transcribed from a handwritten note in another Bible (that of John Caulk, which will be published in a later edition). It was written by Emma Eugenia Davis Caulk (1857-1920), wife of John Wesley Caulk, great grandfather of John C. Lewis.

#### McDowell Family Record

"My great grandfather McDowell & 2 brothers came from Ireland in 1780. Great grandfather McDowell was James.

3 brothers settled in Del. Andrew McDowell a miller by trade and Josephine McD. married & lived near Buck's Bridge. She is dead, died 1914  
Inferred (sic) that one of these 3 brothers was named Alexander Mary was a common. (?)

James McDowell great grandfather married Margret Smith Smith family lived in New Castle Great grandmother died early in years by accident.

Great grandfather died in Newport James McDowell & Wm. McD my grandfather and Alex. McD who died in 1832 unmarried died with cholera Martha A McDowell married her cousin James Smith died in Wilm. 1847 Her husband died 1853 Wilm left 3 sons all deceased James McD. grandfathers brother married Hannah Harper 1829 near Yeatmans Mill.

Brian TRAYNOR is an active genealogist in North Ireland, and while the name FRAYNOR does not appear in any form in the AIS Index of 1860 Delaware, nor in the 1857 Wilmington Directory, there are several TRAINER, TRAINOR listings there. --MFR)
